The Nursery and Transition 1 students will learn about: **Nursery Rhymes**

Language & literacy focus: Children will actively participate in book reading, story telling and singing. Given a familiar, repetitive and predictable story, older toddlers will anticipate what comes next based on pictures and begin to fill in words to the story.

TRANSITION 2 & PRESCHOOL

Transition 2/Preschool students will research: **Things That Move**

Students will begin to describe and exhibit cognition of object positions using place markers on a grid. In addition, they will apply information learned by describing, relating, and categorizing.

STEAM focus: Students will describe and compare the effects of common forces on objects and the impact of gravity, magnetism and mechanical forces.
