## NURSERY & TRANSITION 1

The Nursery and Transition 1 students will learn about opposites this month.

- Inside/outside, up/down, over/under, on/off, open/closed, big/little, hard/soft.

Activities will help children understand and begin to use oral language for conversation and communication.

Cognitive goals: Use senses to investigate environments.
