NURSERY & TRANSITION 1

The Nursery and Transition 1 students will be exploring: *Transportation*

Children will develop language skills in structured contexts, such as through books, finger plays, singing, storytelling and reenacting. In addition, they will begin to build spatial understanding.

STEAM focus: Students will conduct simple experiments, creating sounds and actions while counting.

TRANSITION 2 & PRESCHOOL

Transition 2/Preschool students will examine: *The Solar System*

Children will study planets, galaxies, and space travel. They will use a wide variety of words to label and describe planets and actions. Additionally, they will use information gained from reading by describing, categorizing and comparing with model planets.

STEAM focus: Children will investigate and describe position and motion of projects and use simple measuring tools to learn about objects and distance.
